

## **Starting this CDBrief**

- 1. Computer system requirements to run this CDBrief:**
  - a. A computer with a copy of the Adobe Acrobat reader program. Adobe Acrobat reader runs on the following computer operating systems: Microsoft NT; Microsoft Windows 95, 98, 2000, Me, XP or Vista; Macintosh; and UNIX. The Adobe Acrobat reader can be obtained from Adobe's web site: <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep2.html>
  - b. A computer with a CD-ROM drive.
- 2. For most users,** you should simply insert the CDBrief in your computer CD-ROM drive, and the program will start automatically in less than one minute. If the program does not start automatically, see the suggestions below.
- 3. Troubleshooting.** If the CDBrief does not start automatically, you should try the following steps:
  - a. For computers running Microsoft NT, Windows 95, 98, 2000 Me, XP, or Vista:**
    - i. First try the following step:
      1. Select Start, Run, and type `e:\start`
    - ii. If that does not work, try the following steps:
      1. Close all open Windows and programs.
      2. Click twice on the "My Computer" icon on your desktop.
      3. Click twice on the icon for your CD drive.
      4. Click twice on the file named "Start" or "Start.bat"
    - iii. If that does not work, try the following steps:
      1. Close all open Windows and programs.
      2. Click twice on the "My Computer" icon on your desktop.
      3. Click twice on the icon for your CD drive.
      4. Click twice on the file named "MainMenu" or "MainMenu.pdf"
      5. If that does not work, it probably means that you do not have the required Adobe Acrobat reader installed. To install the Adobe Acrobat reader, go to the following internet address:

      6. Click twice on the file named "MainMenu" or "MainMenu.pdf".
  - b. For Macintosh computers:**
    - i. You will first need to install the Adobe Acrobat reader. If that program is not already installed on your computer, you should open your Web Browser (Internet Explorer or Firefox), and go to the Adobe Web site: [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com), and download the Acrobat reader for your version of the Macintosh software.
    - ii. Click on the icon for your CD drive
    - iii. Click on the file named "MainMenu" or "MainMenu.pdf" on the CD.
